


KEY ASPECTS: CITY & COMMUTING AREA





Europe-example 2: Grand Paris



Produces more than 25% of national GDP





- Aimed at organising relations between Paris and the territorial entities of the larger urban area to develop a sustainable urban, social and economic model at the metropolitan region level.
- Creation of a dual level of inter-municipality:
 the Grand Paris metropolis and twelve "territories".
- The metropolis level and the territory level are responsible for distinct (sometimes shared) policy areas and have their own governance structures.

Eindhoven knowledge city-region, NL



- Bottom-up voluntary regional association with a legal base (allowed by Dutch law)
- Strengthening the economic structure of the area
- Cross-border strategic cooperation with Belgium, Germany, and France (supported by national level)






